

4 FUN IDEAS FOR YOUR NEXT TEAM MEETING

RECOGNIZING CONTRIBUTIONS

Everyone starts sitting at the table with eyes closed. Pick 2-3 people to quietly stand. Ask them to tap a coworker on the shoulder who... "is a leader on the team, is a good listener, has great ideas etc. Repeat changing the 2-3 people standing until everyone has had a chance in both roles.





BUILDING CONNECTIONS

Meet my new best friend is the name of this game. Ask your team to partner up with someone they want to get to know better. Their mission is to learn 5 new facts about one another during their time together. If time permits have the group share the fun new things they learned with the entire team!

DEVELOPING COMMUNICATION

Take a piece of string tied in a circle and invite everyone to hold onto it. While still holding onto the string, challange them to make shapes (circle, rectangle, etc) with the string by working together. You can ask them to close their eyes or not speak to make it more challenging as their communication improves!





BRAINSTORM WARM-UP

Before your next team meeting **grab** an object from the office. Challenge the team to brainstorm a number of unique ways to repurpose that item. Divide them into smaller groups to create and **deliver a sales pitch** to sell it using their favourite new use. Best pitch wins bragging rights!
